Mayfield Rules

Mayfield is a turf field which must be treated with care. Please read the attached rules and be sure that your parents and players are aware of them. Failure to follow the rules could lead to loss of Mayfield field privileges.

Mayfield Games

Games are tightly scheduled at Mayfield so games **MUST** start on time or you may run out of time. There is a large warm-up field between the fields that can be used for pre-game warm-ups.

Corner Flags

Corner flags at Mayfield are in the locked storage shed. Flags must be returned to the shed unless another permitted user is playing after you.

The shed is locked. You access it by opening the combination box attached to the building on the right of the shed. To open it, press "clear" then 8 - 9 - 06 and press the top button down. The key to the shed is inside. **DO NOT LOSE THIS KEY.** Enter the code again and return the key/key pad immediately after opening and closing the shed.

- Metal cleats or long plastic cleats (longer than ¼")
- Food or drinks on the field of play (except water)
- Staking of shade structures to synthetic turf
- Penetrating turf with stakes or flags
- Marking of lines onto turf with paint, tape, or any other method
